Why was Dispatch built?

- Built in 2012
- Admissions using expensive vended product to send out recruiting materials
- Maui needed a single service to generate and send messages

What does Dispatch do?


Provides email, print, voice, and SMS communications for various applications inside and outside of ITS.




How is it used?

- Recruiting prospective students (email)
- Sending out official decision letters (email, print -> printer)
- Building U-Bills (print -> sftp)
- Universal Workflow notifications (email)
- HR Timesheet notifications (email)
- Class list notifications (email)
- Many more


A firehouse of messages




Messages Sent by Client

Managing Content - Templates

- Easy way to manage content
- HTML
- WYSIWYG editor included for dynamic templates (templates inside of templates)
- FreeMarker templating language
- Custom tags for letterhead, signatures
- TwiML for voice calls

Tying it together - Communications

- Grouped by campaign
- Join Population with Template
- Destinations: SMTP, Printer, Files service, FTP/SFTP, or Twilio
- Callbacks
- Basic scheduling (once, daily, weekly, monthly)
- Subscription lists

Analytics

- Report on open rate
- Click throughs
- Delivery rate and throughput
- Build follow-up populations based on opens or link clicks

- Play 1.2.7 (Java)
- Oracle 11g
- Flyway for DB migrations
- Redis for caching
- Bootstrap 2.3.2
- jQuery Flot for charting

- Amazon S3 for static image delivery
- Redactor for WYSIWYG editor
- Twilio for SMS/Voice messaging
- Angular
